to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Dr. J. E. Morrow of Greenville,  
R. 3, D. #2 in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Dr. J. E. Morrow, all that certain lot, piece or parcel  
of land situated in County and State aforesaid  
on West side of Woodjoin road; Beginning at a  
stone on East side of said road at "The Side Forks"  
and runs thence with old abandoned (Greer)  
road  $51^{\circ}41' E$  4.32 chains to an angle in said road;
