NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, B W Weathers  
in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
R E Barrett

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

R. E. Barrett, all of two lots # 5 and 6 accord-  
ing to a survey made by J. A. Adams on the  
4th day of April 1910, and that the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Bounded by old  
stage road, Sidney Smith, Lot # 4, et al.  
Commencing at an iron pin at corner of  
Lot # 4 and running thence S. 26 1/4 W. 150  
feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot # 33; thence  
N. 63 3/4 W. 120 feet to corner Sidney Smith  
line to iron pin on old stage road; thence  
S. 63 3/4 E. 100 feet to beginning corner corner,  
being the same conveyed to me by deed  
from M. E. Meadors, dated Jan. 8th. 1917,  
and recorded in office R. M. B. for Green-  
ville County in Book 42 at page 33.
