(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. D. Lanford, aforesaid certain piece, parcel and lot
of land being in South Carolina, Greenville County,
City of Greenville on Stale Street, and known as
lot #6 on plat made by W. M. Hudson, dated May
24th, 1905 and recorded in plat book A at page 108
in office of P. M. C. in and for Greenville County,
and for the following course and distance to
writ—Beginning at an iron pin on South side
of Stale street and running whence S. 66 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 46 $\frac{2}{3}$
