 in consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred & 00/00 DOLLARS,
 to me, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
L. M. White,
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

L. M. White his heirs and assigns, all that piece parcel
 or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County
 and State aforesaid, about two miles West of the City
 of Greenville and being a portion of a subdivision
 known as "City Street". Beginning at a stake at
 North East corner of Henderson and Preall street, and
 running thence N. 0° 30' E. 150 feet to a stake corner of
 lots Nos. 39 + 40 thence S. 89 1/2 E. 150 feet to a stake in
 an a few foot alley, thence along said alley S. 0° 30'
 E. 150 feet to a stake on Preall Street, thence along
 said Street N. 89 1/2 E. 150 ft. to the beginning corner
