NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Me, S. P. McLebelle and C. J. McLebelle
of Greenville County in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of \$468.80 Four hundred sixty eight and 80/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Daniel Johnson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Daniel Johnson his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing eleven and seventy-two hundredths (11 72/100) acres more or less, situate and being in South township, State and County aforesaid and having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a stone 7.3 0 m, on W. E. Mackey's line, thence N 73 3/4 W. 45 to a cedar stump 7.3 0 m, thence N. 84 3/4 W. 9.55 to a stake 7.3, near a spring on head of small branch, thence down the meanders of said branch 5.4 2 chains to where it runs into another branch, thence up the other branch 4.50 chains to a stake 7.3 m, thence S. 76 1/2 E. 8.53 to a stone 7.3 m; thence S. 58 1/4 E. 10.17 to a stone 7.3 m, on said Mackey's line thence N. 43 1/4 E. 8.75 to the beginning corner bounded lands of W. E. Mackey, C. C. Wood and S. P. and C. J. McLebelle and more fully represented by a plat made by W. M. F. Lee, Surveyor, dated March, 31, 1919 reference thereto being had will more fully appear, the same being a part of the tract of land conveyed to us by deed from John J. heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

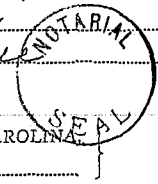
