NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. R. Amick of the County of Greenville State and County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Forty Seven Hundred and fifty and 100/100 DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by D. J. Murray

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said D. J. Murray his heirs and assigns all that certain piece parcel or lot of land, lying and being situated in County and State aforesaid, to-wit: Lot 4 of the City of Greenville on the north side of East Ave fronting 87 Eighty Seven feet on said East Avenue and running back Two Hundred feet parallel lines, being all of the land included in the Hedge and fence around said Lot said Lot being part of Lot # 16 on Plat of Emma B and Elizabeth E. Jones, said plat Recorded in office of R. M. C. of Greenville County in Plat Book 6 at Pages 37 & 38.

As a part consideration of the purchase price of above described Lot said D. J. Murray agrees to pay and does hereby assume the payment of note and mortgage signed by W. C. Steadman to H. H. Miffee for the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars being recorded in R. M. C. office of Greenville County, State aforesaid in Book 6 page 247 in which District no paid to this date, said amount being reduced to said sum (\$4000.00) Four Thousand Dollars on date of this deed. On this lot is situated a six room residence one and one half story single roof residence

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said D. J. Murray his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said D. J. Murray his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
