(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Eliza Daughan, her heirs and assigns, all one undivided interest of in & to all that piece or parcel or lot of land situated lying duey being in Greenville County, Faust Township, South Carolina, containing three and one half acres, more or less, and being the South Easter Partion of the lot hereinabove referred to.

Begins at a stone on I. S. Lewis and Alfred Walker's Conner and running thereof N. 3 deg 5.38 to stake thence N. 87° 26.6.50 to stake, thence S 3 deg 5.38 to stake thence S 87.6 6.50 to beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
