Terrell, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No 11, Section "E" of the Stone Laid Company, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "A" of real estate on pages 337-345, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of West Stone Avenue corner of lot No. 10, and running thence with stone avenue S. 83.13 E. seventy-two feet to iron pin corner of lot No. 12; thence S. 0.5 W. two hundred and forty-nine feet to an iron pin; thence N. 85.55 W. seventy-two feet to an iron pin rear corner of lot No. 10 thence N. 0.5 E. two hundred and fifty-three feet to the beginning corner, being the lot conveyed to me by W.
