NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we W. D. Parrish and T. C. Powers
 of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable Consideration, DOLLARS,
 to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Eugene B. Smith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Relented, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Relense unto the said Eugene B. Smith, all that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the Southeast corner of Augusta Street and Tindall Avenue, and having the following Metres and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin, the Southeast corner of Augusta St. and Tindall Avenue and running thence with Augusta St. S. 75° 42' E. Ninety-one (91) feet to an iron pin, corner of lot 710, 3; thence with line of lot No 3 N. 62° 5' E. one hundred and eighty-nine (189) feet to an iron pin on line of lot No 43, thence N. 78° 42' W. Sixty-Six and Seven tenths (66.7) feet to an iron pin on Tindall Avenue, thence S. 67° 14' W. with Tindall Avenue, one hundred and eighty-five and one-tenth (185.1) feet to the beginning corner. Being lot No 2 as shown on Plat of Eagle Park Property, made by J. E. Dalton, and recorded July 20th, 1915 in Plat Book C, page 238, in the office of R. M.
