NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *I Sarah Griffith of Greenville* in the State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of *One hundred & Twenty Dollars* DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *M. A. Griffith*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *M. A. Griffith* a certain piece, parcel or Tract of land, a part of my interest in Seventy acres tract, the estate of Fleming Griffith deceased, a part of Twenty Seven acres surveyed by W. P. Graham Oct 5, 1892, the boundaries including ten more acres to be deed by Catharine Foister to the said *M. A. Griffith* being divided, and sold. Four division among the heirs of said deceased situated lying and being in Greenville County and State of South Carolina on waters of Laurel Creek, Branch waters of Reedy River, Beginning white oak 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ thence N. 85 E. 12.50 to poplar on East side of Laurel Creek 3 $\frac{1}{2}$; thence up the meanders of said Creek to a Sycamore on the West Bank of said Creek 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ thence N. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 17.94 to a stone on old line 3 $\frac{1}{2}$, thence S. 41 W. 153 to a stone on said line 3 $\frac{1}{2}$, thence S. 11 E. 19.55 to the beginning white Oak, containing Twenty Seven in the boundary, Seventeen acres deeded, the same, more or less.

Griffith*, his heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
