DEED TO

Mrs. Asa O. Ferguson

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, William G. Surrine of the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and other valuable considerations, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Asa O. Ferguson,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Asa O. Ferguson and his heirs and assigns, all those certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying, and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lots numbered seven (7), ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty-one (21), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23), twenty-four (24) and twenty-five (25) on a plat of Mrs. Asa O. Ferguson's property made by Phil D. Kester, dated March 22, 1915, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "C" page 254. Lots numbered 7, 9, 11, 12, and 13 are each fifty-seven and a half (57 $\frac{1}{2}$) by one hundred and fifty (150) feet, fronting on the west side of Milton Street, north of Park Avenue (formerly known as Carrie Street); lots numbered 14 to 25 inclusive lie on the east side of Mansell Street, north of Park Avenue. Said lots have, respectively, the causes and distances shown on said plat. There are the same lots of land conveyed to me, the said William G. Surrine, by C. Murray Master, by deed bearing date March 10, 1916, and recorded in said office on the day of its date in Deed Book No. 40, page 127; except that lot no. 4 on said plat was also conveyed to me by said Master, but has been conveyed by me to Burnah V. Jennings by deed bearing date May 24, 1916, and recorded in said office in Deed Book No. 29, page 14.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Asa O. Ferguson and her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Asa O. Ferguson and her heirs and assigns, against myself and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, through me.
