in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Turner

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
J. T. Turner all that certain tract or parcel of land  
situate, lying, and being in state and county aforesaid  
said in Glassy Mt. Township, beginning on a stone  
L. P. Barnett and R. C. Evans corner, thence with R. C.  
Evans line to a stone L. P. Barnett's, R. C. Evans Wellborn  
Ewell, thence N. E. to Black Oak on the Glassy Mt.  
Road, oak down, now stone, thence with said road  
to a stone on side of said road, thence S W. to be-  
ginning corner, containing two and one half acres  
more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. T. Turner  
his heirs and assigns, forever.

forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. T. Turner

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
