(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

R. C. Slattow, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate
 lying and being on Cowee River, Austin Township, County and State
 aforesaid, containing *Forty-Two and one half (42 1/2) acres more*
or less, lying as part of a tract of *137 1/4 acres*, known as the *Will*
Coker Place, and having the following metes and bounds as
 shown on plat of *R. L. Adams, Surveyor*, dated *Feby 25th, 1918*,
 to-wit: Beginning at a willow stake on Cowee River, at or near
 mouth of *Brockman's branch*, and running thence *S. 45° W. 26.90* to
 an iron pin in plantation road; thence *S. 89° E. 22.00* to an iron
 pin on *Cowee River*; thence up the river to an iron pin corner of *A*
