 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Belle B. Heunt  
of Greenville City S.C. in the State aforesaid,  
 in consideration of the sum of Eighteen hundred DOLLARS,  
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. F. White

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. F. White his heirs and assigns all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid About two miles west of the Court House and being a portion of a subdivision known as City View: Beginning at a stake on Brandon Road 180 ft. from Oneal St. joint corner of lot Nos. 7+8 and running thence with joint lines of said lots in a Westerly direction, one hundred and forty six ft. (146) to a stake joint corner of lots Nos. 7, 8, + 4 N. thence in a Southerly direction 116' 10" ft. to a stake at joint corner of lot No. 8 and J. F. White corner (formerly J. D. Sheppards) thence with joint lines of lot No. 8 and J. F. Whites piece in an Easterly direction 160 ft. to a stake on Brandon Road, thence in a Northerly direction with said Brandon Road 58' 9" ft. to a stake at the beginning corner, same being known as lot No. 8 according to a plat made by F. S. Rogers of the City View property, December 1908 and being the same lot conveyed to me by H. W. Henderson and J. F. Heunt Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>. 1913 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County the 9<sup>th</sup>. day of January 1913 in Vol. 24 page 35.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. F. White, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself + my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. F. White, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
