

Sallie H. Harris DEED TO D. L. Stewart

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Sallie H. Harris of Virginia in consideration of the sum of two Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, to me in hand paid and before the sealing of these presents by D. L. Stewart of Greenville, S. C. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

D. L. Stewart. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid in the fifth ward, and having the following metes and bounds, beginning at a point on Harris Street (ninety-three feet from the Southeast corner of Harris and Augusta streets) and running thence in a southeasterly direction along lines of lots nos. 1 and 2, for a distance of one hundred and fourteen feet to a stake on a alley; thence along said alley, in a northeasterly direction sixty feet to corner of lot No. 25; thence along said lot in a northwesterly direction one hundred and fourteen feet to a stake on Harris street; thence in a southeasterly direction along Harris street sixty feet to the beginning corner, and being known as no. 24 on a plat of H. E. Harris estate, by H. D. News, dated Oct. 22, 1913.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

D. L. Stewart and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

D. L. Stewart and his heirs and assigns, against

me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
