to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Turner

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. T. Turner, all that certain parcel or tract of
land situate lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid in Glassy Mt. Township,
Beginning on stone Glassy Mt. Road, with
said Road to a stone one ch. L. P. Barnett and
D. P. Evans corner, thence near N. E. 9 chains to a
stone L. P. Barnett and D. P. Evans corner, thence
N. 18 E. 14 ch. to white oak stump near Spring
old corner, thence N. 2 1/2 chs. to a stone, thence
near South 18 1/2 chs. to the beginning corner,
containing 10 4/5 acres more or less bounded
by lands of D. P. Evans and L. P. Barnett.
