(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Clyde Hall All that certain piece parcel or lot
of land situate lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township near
the Town of Greer lying North of Emma Street, and
on the North Side of Morrow Street, fronting on
Morrow Street 45 feet and having a depth of 150 feet,
and being lot #18 and 1/2 of lot #19 as shown on a
plat of land known as Morrow Park same being
surveyed for C. D. Chandler by A. H. Hoffman March
1918, being recorded in the office of R. M. C. for
Greenville County in plat book "E" page 91.

And being a part of the same lot of land con-
