DEED TO Thomas J. Crane

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. R. Wilson

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 20/100 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Thomas J. Crane

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Thomas J. Crane, his heirs and assigns forever; All that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville on Perry Ave. in the City of Greenville in Ward Five, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat hereto prepared by W.A. Adams bearing date August 28th 1911 to wit: Beginning at a pin on Perry Ave. North side on the South West corner of land originally belonging to Henry Fiedner and on the South east corner of land formerly belonging to James H. Price, and running thence along Perry Ave. S. 71 E. 52 feet to an iron pin of Perry Ave. thence N. 19 E. 173 feet along the line of land belonging to the devisees of Henry Fiedner deceased to an iron pin thence along line of last mentioned land S. 71 E. 90 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19 E. 80 feet to an iron pin on the north-west corner of Mrs. Aurelia P. Morris' land; thence S. 71 E. 56 feet to an iron pin on the old ware line thence N. 20 W. 201 feet to an iron pin on said line, thence N. 71 W. 71 feet to an iron pin on the Price line; thence on the last mentioned line S. 19 W. 409 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by L.L. Barr on the 31st day of Jan. 1909 see Vol. 39 at page 125.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas J. Crane, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Thomas J. Crane, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
