NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Burrell Cox
in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and sixty two and 5/10 (\$262.50) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.T. Bishop

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J.T. Bishop, all that piece, parcel or tract of land lying
and being situate in Saluda Township in Greenville
County and in the State aforesaid on branch waters of
North Saluda River and is a part of a tract of land
conveyed to me by E. G. Kelly on the 21st day of January
1904 and runs as follows

Beginning at a stone on lands of heirs of Albert Finley
(dec.) thence N. 21° E. 21.50 to a stone corner heirs of Albert Finley
thence S 33 1/2° E 5.20 thence S 67° E 3.30 thence S 65 1/4° E 4.60 to
stone corner near road leading from Cross Plains Church
to Runcombe Road, thence along said road 24.47 to a stone
corner, thence S 47 1/2° E 7.00 thence S 56 1/2° E 5.00 to the
beginning corner, containing 20 1/2 acres, more or less
bounded by land of Benny Perry, Burrell Cox, heirs of
Albert Finley and J.T. Bishop

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.T. Bishop his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.T. Bishop

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
