Mayfield, as trustees of the 1st Methodist Church of Greenville (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. F. Few, S. C. Zimmerman, M. S. Marchant and S. A. Mayfield, as trustees of said Church, all my right to and interest in all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the County and state aforesaid, and fully described in deed of S. A. Mayfield to B. F. Few and others, as Trustees, dated the 30th day of Nov. 1886, and recorded in R. M. C. office in and for said County and state in deed Book S. S., Pg. 347. C. heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
