NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That S. L. Vaughan of Butler Township in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Alice Green

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Alice Green, all that parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Butler Township, County of and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and boundaries to-wit: Beginning at iron pin St. M. Watson line, thence N. 17 5/8 W. 19.20 Ch. to iron pin at head of Road, thence along road N. 9 E. 24 3/4 Ch. to iron pin at edge of road, thence S. 78 3/4 W. 27.74 to stone 3x8 in thence E. 26 E. 13.78 to stone (Miller & Green corner) thence (Miller's line) along same line 25 1/2 Ch. to iron pin at dry Branch, thence S. 7 1/2 E. 3.15 to iron and concrete corner, thence N. 82 E. 7.50 to stake, in branch maple witness thence N. 84 E. 4.60 along Watsons line to the beginning corner, containing 77 acres more or less, Bounded by lands of St. M. Watson, Miller estate, S. L. Vaughan and others.
