NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Norman Clark of Denver  
County Colorado in the State aforesaid  
(in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and twenty (\$420.00) DOLLARS,  
to Mrs. H. F. Gaylord of Greenville County S. C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
H. F. Gaylord and his heirs and assigns, All of my right,  
title, and undivided interest (the same being 1/8) of an  
and to all of the Estate of J. J. Gaylord, deceased, situate  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina and  
County of Greenville, in Austin Township, and containing  
11.2 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Dolph  
Hood, Sue Jones, G. T. D. Hughes, B. G. Thackston, Sam  
Armstrong, W. J. Thackston, Thad Thackston. The  
above interest was inherited by me from J. J. Gaylord  
who was my Grand-father. This deed being intended  
by me to convey all of my right, title and interest of  
every nature and kind unto H. F. Gaylord, in fee  
simple of which my said grandfather, J. J. Gaylord  
did, seized and possessed or in which he had  
or claim any interest in.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

H. F. Gaylord, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and  
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

H. F. Gaylord, and his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
