

Bent S. Lewis DEED TO R. E. Henry

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That B. S. Lewis in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. E. Henry

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. E. Henry, his heirs, and assigns, All that lot of land situate in Ward 2 in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin corner of Washington Street (or Road) and Joy Street, and running thence with Washington Street N 69.35 E. 92 feet to an iron pin corner of lot no. 2; thence with line of lot no. 2, N. 15 W. 212 feet to an iron pin on 10 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 69.35 W. 92 feet to an iron pin, corner of Joy Street and said alley; thence with Joy Street S. 15 E. 212 feet to the beginning corner and being designated as lot no. 1 on plat made by W. D. Nevele November 12th. 1908, and being the same land conveyed to me by B. S. Lewis, by deed, dated the 12th day of February, 1912, and recorded in Vol. 17 page 385.
