H. J. Wham, all that certain, piece parcel or lot of land

 the Town of Gees, S. C. Beginning at a iron pin on
 Arlington Avenue running thence North 85° - 26' sixty
 five feet to iron pin on J. D. Ashmore's line, thence
 West 116 feet to iron pin thence South 90° - 0' 65 feet
 to iron pin thence East 90° - 0' 110.9 feet to the
