County of Greenville,NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That O H Hiclesin consideration of the sum of \$1000 Dollars and other valuable DOLLARS,  
to James George in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said James George, his heirs and assigns forever, All those three lots of land situated in Ward Five of the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid together fronting 150 feet on the south side of Franklin Street, and having a depth of 915 feet and containing an aggregate 33,650 square feet, more or less. For a Description by metes and bounds and courses and distances see Plat Book "A", page 163 in the Office for said County and State; these parcels of land being numbered in said plat as 1, 2 and 3.Lots 1 and 2 were conveyed to W.W. Williamson by W.H. Hicles deceased, on June 17<sup>th</sup> 1909, by deed recorded in the County Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Volume 4, page 468, and lot no. 3 was conveyed to W.W. Williamson by Mrs. Sallie H. Williamson.

On lot no. 1 there is a small stone building.
