the said Sunie H. Smith all that lot or parcel of land

situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid
about two and a half miles west of Greenville Court
house on south side of the Southern R. R. in a section
known as Forestown, fronting on a street running
from Southern R. R. to Friendship Church and known
as Friendship St.

Beginning on Friendship St. corner of Mance
Jackson's lot, at an iron pin and running in a
Western direction 134 ft. 3 in. with Mance Jackson's
line to iron pin on Robert Smith thence in
a N. W. direction 16 ft. with Robert Smith's line and
