

Deed to D. F. Bradley from N. M. Caldwell

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, County of Greenville. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, N. M. Caldwell, of the County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten and 00/100 and other valuable considerations in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by D. F. Bradley

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said D. F. Bradley, his heirs assigns for ever all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid on the west side of Reedy River, and nearly touching said River near the Lanes line, bounded by lands of the Estate of James H. Latimore, Jno. H. Latimore, W. M. Mc Turk and others containing one hundred and twelve acres more or less. Said land is a portion of the Homestead on which the late Heintz Gulesider resided. For more full and complete description see plat of same made by James P. Willis bearing date Apr. 2 1908 and which is made apart of this deed and being the same lands conveyed to me by deed of B. P. Traubman bearing date of 15th Dec 1916 and recorded in Register Mense Conveyance for County aforesaid and in State aforesaid on the 21st day of Dec. 1916 in Vol. 43 page 12.
