

Greenville County

This contract made and entered into this 15th day of June 1918 between R. C. Williamson and Enore Power Company, its assigns, is as follows: The said R. C. Williamson for and in consideration of the sum of \$122 in hand paid by the said Enore Power Company, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted unto the said Enore Power Company, its assigns, assigns, the right and privilege to raise a dam on the Shoals on Kedy River to such height as they or their assigns or assigns may desire.

It is further agreed as part of this contract that should after the raising of such dam, the lands of the said R. C. Williamson should in any way be injured or damaged by the water from backing up such dam as said Power Company may raise on said stream, the said Enore Power Company hereby binds itself, its assigns, to pay the amount of such damage to the said R. C. Williamson heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, the amount of such damage, in case the parties hereto cannot agree upon the same, shall be ascertained and fixed in the following manner, to-wit:

The said R. C. Williamson heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, is to select one arbitrator, and the said Enore Power Company to select another, and these two arbitrators to select a third; if these two cannot agree upon such third arbitrator then he is to be selected by Clerk of Court; and if he will not make such selection, then such selection to be made by Probate Judge, and if he will not thus by Sheriff; and if for any reason arbitrators cannot be chosen, by a majority of them cannot agree, then the amount of such damage is to be determined by Court. The award of said arbitrators shall be final and conclusive in determining the amount of said damage.

Know all men by these presents that we J. M. Ballenger & J. R. Cole Trustees for Paris School District No. 1 of said County and State, in consideration of the sum of \$1000 and of the sum of \$1000 Dollars to us in hand paid by the City of Greenville South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to go in and upon that tract of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of A. A. Green, A. A. Green on the East; Cole Estate on the South; and the main brick road on the West, and to construct and maintain, repair, improve, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, lines for the purpose of transmitting power, light, electricity and telephone service, together with the right to use, install, repair, and telephone premises for the purpose of constructing, said lines, and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut, remove and plant trees and other like things on the premises that may in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

The payment of the sum of \$1000 is accepted in full settlement of all claims for said land, and any damages to crops planted shall be paid for at a date to be agreed upon, and if such cannot be arrived at mutually, the damage shall be determined by arbitrators, one to be chosen by the holder of this grant and the two so appointed to be chosen by the holder of this grant, two of the three arbitrators shall be chosen. The decision of any two of the three arbitrators shall be final.
