TITLE TO REAL ESTATE.

*J. P. Reese* DEED TO *S.C. Dickson*

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *J. P. Reese* in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Ten (\$10) Dollars and other Consideration* DOLLARS, to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *S.C. Dickson*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *S.C. Dickson*. All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land situate, lying and being in the state and County aforesaid in *Oncal Township in Beaufort County* and having the following lines and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a Cherry tree 3x6 ft on *Creek* and running thence N. 29 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. 13.46 to a white Oak 3x6 m. thence S. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 23.25 to a stone 3x6 m. thence S. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 9.08 to a stone 3x6 m. on *Strawhise*, thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 12.25 to the beginning corner and containing fifteen acres more or less and being bounded by lands of *James Dew, Evans, Gilbert Whidow, William Stoen,* and *Alley Head* etc. this being the same tract of land conveyed to me by *C.W.
