(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *A. Culverton Jr.* All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on *McNamee Avenue* in the city of Greenville, county and state aforesaid, being lot #15 of Block 13 of *Cagle Park Company's* land as shown on Plat Book C at page 138 and having the following lines and boundaries:
