Hightower

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said E.M. Hightower, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on head waters of Wild Cat Creek, the same being branch waters of South Tyger River, containing twenty and one-tenth (20-1/10) acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake 3x3m in middle of the Bramlett road running thence S. 82-3/4 E. 12.74 chains to a P.O. 3x on (dead); thence N. 26 W. 12.24 chains to stone 3x on; thence N. 16-1/2 W. 6.90 chains to stone 3x on; thence N. 84-1/2 W. 12.20 chains to iron pin 3x Bramlett's road; thence with said road to beginning 3x; this being the same land conveyed to me by John B. Crain by deed bearing date of Feb. 25th, 1919 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. Greenville County in Vol. 34, page 504. The outside lines were run from a plat made by James K. Dickson, said land is a portion of the same land that was willed by P.C. Pitman to O.L. Pitman and A.J. Pitman.

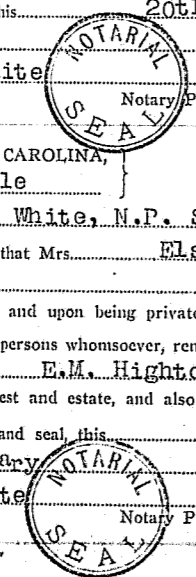
