(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

S. M. Kinton, his heirs and assigns, All those three certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County and Township of Greenville near Monaghan Mills, about 2 miles West of Greenville Court House, and being a portion of a sub division known as City View, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
