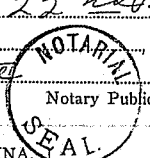

H. L. Spears and J. R. Malloy, All that tract or parcel of land lying and situated in Glassy Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on Jamison Mill Creek waters of South Paeolet River, said land being on west side of Mill Creek, beginning on corner of T.M. Belue Mill tract on Mrs. Harriett Stewarts line running thence with said line to a chestnut 3X Mrs. Harriett Stewarts and Mrs. Margaret A. Prewetts corner on bank of creek running thence N.E. thence N.W. up said Creek with meandering thereof to T.M.
