 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Birdie Monteith, all that certain lot of land  
 situate on Tindal Avenue in the sixth Ward of  
 the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid,  
 known and designated as lot #60, block 6, in a plat of  
 Eagle Park Company, recorded in plat book 6, page 238,  
 being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Eagle Park
