(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
R. L. Simpson his heirs and assigns all that certain
piece parcel or tract of land consisting of three and
three-fourths (3.75) acres, more or less including
the Right of way, fifty (50) feet wide on East side
of Southern Railway Co's track, situate being and
being in Groce Township, State and County aforesaid
between Southern Railway Co's track and Depot
branch, bounded by lands of A. N. Eskew, Piedmont
Manufacturing Co, W. B. Simmonson and others, Beginning
