(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Eileen T. Arnold, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, S.C. and having the following written and bounded according to a plat thereof as recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds conveyance for Greenville County, State of S.C. in Plat Book "A" at page 179 (Kingsway as portion of Boyce's lawn property) to wit:- Commencing at an iron pin on south side of Pettigree Street corner of lots #1 and 2, thence 81' 15-0' E. along line of said lots One Hundred and Ninety six feet (96) to an iron pin to line of lot #5, thence 26' 26-45' E. along line of said lot fifty six feet (66) eight (8) inches to iron pin corner of lots #2 and 3, thence 26' 15-0' N. along said lots #2 and 3, One hundred and Ninety Six (96) feet to an iron pin on Pettigree Street, thence 26' 26-45' N. along said street Eighty six (66) feet eight (8) inches to an iron pin the beginning corner subdivision of the Boyce's lawn property revised January 22nd, by J.
