KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

DOLLARS
to me
in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. R. Terry

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. R. Terry, a certain lot, tract or parcel of land located in Fairview Township, State and County aforesaid, lying on the branch waters of Reddy River on east side of road leading from Fork Shoals to Terry's old shop, being a part of that tract of land conveyed to J. C. Willis by M. Redden partly by deed dated Jan. 8th 1894 and recorded in R. M. C. office in Greenville Co. Vol. 2 page 231, known as old Ford place land bounded by lands of J. M. Terry, J. V. Redden & J. R. Terry containing thirty seven and 29/100 acres (37.28 ac.) more or less, having the following notes and bounds as a section of a plat made by James A. Adams dated Dec. 25th 1897, to wit:
