(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. F. Sprague all that tract or parcel of land situated
 lying and being in the County & State aforesaid
 in the waters of South Tyger River and joining lands
 of David Cannon, Wm. B. Thompson and others and
 known as a part of the home stead tract of Lakin
 Cannon Dec. having the following course & distance
 to wit: Beginning at a stake at the bend of
 River 10 chains above the sweet house corner and
 running thence N. 13 1/2 E. 9.70 ch. to a stake in
 field, thence N. 33 1/2 E. 22.90 ch. to a stake on
