

DEED TO William Selby Southwestern Life

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That William Selby

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Four Hundred and Sixty-Four DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

Southwestern Life Insurance Company

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Southwestern Life Insurance Company, All my interest (the same being an undivided one-half) in that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, near the corporate limits of said City and fronting on a road leading to Whick Springs, containing one and one-half (1 1/2) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of an unnamed 60 foot street opening on the County Road, and running thence with said street N 71° 45' W 440.9 feet to a stake; thence N 9° 04' E 207 feet to a stake; thence S 71° 45' E 189.3 feet to a stake; thence S 7° 10' W 104 feet to a stake; thence S 71° 45' E 208.2 feet to a stake; thence S 7° 10' W 209 feet to the point of beginning; being the same lot of land conveyed to me and B. H. Peace by J. B. Peace by deed recorded in Book 10, page 211 reference to which deed is craved, as well as to plot of Stone Sand Company, recorded in Plot Book A Page 337, and to the plot of a subdivision of Tract #7 of the Stone Sand Company's lands made by Harry Gee, L. E. dated January 26, 1910, the premises herein above described being a portion of said Tract #7.
