(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

A. M. Ballenger, all that certain pieces, parcels or tract
of land situate, lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid, about five miles above the
Town of Travelers Rest, S.C. and having the
following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning
at an old road, joint corner with land
now owned by B. L. Johnson, and running
thence N. 51° 4' W. 7. 91 to a pine 70 m.; thence N.
72 1/2 W. 10. 12 to a stake; S. 54 21. 26. 63 to an iron
pin in the Buscombe Road; thence down the old
road S. 33 E. 11. 50 to an iron pin; thence N. 40 1/3 E.
30. 38 to a stake; thence S. 72 1/2 E. 5. 40 to a pine 34 m.,
thence S. 55 E. 7. 67 to the beginning corner and
containing 2 3 acres, more or less, as surveyed
by W. A. Hester, August 30th, 1915. Being a part
