KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Heirs of James B. Wyrill, Henry D. Wyrill, Emma M. Fair, Frances K. Blakely, Almette S. Gringson, and James T. Wyrill of Greenville County, Heirs of the late James B. Wyrill, in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Twenty One Hundred and Seventy five (2175) DOLLARS, to be paid in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Amelia E. Hodges of the State and County aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Amelia E. Hodges, all that certain piece, parcel, and tract of land, situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid on both sides of the Hunt Bridge road and known as lot No. 4 in the division of the real estate of the late James B. Wyrill, adjoining lots No. 5 and 6 and having the following writer and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the old White horse road and thence S. 58 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 35.00 or chains to Chestnut stump gone, thence N. 36 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ to stake, thence N. 58 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 35.00 to stake, thence S. 36 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ to the beginning containing fifty eight and six tenth acres, more or less, (less) all of that other parcel or lot of land situated on both sides of Reedy River, own the home place of the said James B. Wyrill and known as tract No. 6 in the division of the bottom land of the said James B. Wyrill Beginning at a bevel gun and thence N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 16.00 to a stake, thence S. 46 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 5.60 to stake, thence S. 41 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 12.80 to a stake, thence N. 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.85 to Sycamore, thence N. 65 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 2.74 to the beginning containing eight acres more or less.
