KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That me, Joe A. McCullough, C. C. Hood,  
and J. D. Smith, of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
Twenty-five (\$25.00) DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by Andy Harris

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Andy Harris, his heirs and assigns: - All that certain  
piece, parcel and lot of land, situate lying and being  
in Ward four of the City and County of Greenville and  
State of South Carolina, on the South side of an alley  
running parallel with McBee Avenue, in the rear  
of the Colored Baptist Church, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron  
pipe on said Alley, and running thence S. 18 W. 86.2  
feet to an iron pipe, thence N. 73-28 W. 31.8 feet to an  
iron pipe; thence N. 38-04 E. 92.6 feet to the beginning  
corner, and being part of the same land heretofore  
conveyed by Andy Harris to C. C. Hood, Joe A. McCul-  
lough & J. D. Smith.
