(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Mary E. Coleman, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Greenville Township about two miles north of the City of Greenville in a subdivision known as Sans Soucy Villa and being one of the lots subdivided and platted for Vivian B. Gibson said plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C at page 13. The lot herein conveyed having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a point on the west side of Brockman Ave. corner of Young Street, and running thence along Brockman Ave. N. 10-30 E. 60 ft. to a stake; thence N. 57-25 W. 166.8 ft. to a stake; thence S. 12-0 W. 59 ft. to a stake on Young St. Thence with Young St. S. 57-25 E. 170 feet to the beginning corner land being the same lot conveyed to me by J.
