(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. A. Jones and H. Frank Smith, all that certain tract of land situate in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing fifty seven and four tenths (57.4) acres, more or less. Beginning on a branch of a stone and running thence S. 33° W. 10.62 to a stone in old field thence S. 17° 15' E. 22.38 to a stone on Mr. Reuges line; thence S. 42 1/2 E. 17.00 to a stone near a big poplar; thence N. 57 E. 9.08 to a stone in branch; thence S. 52 1/2 E. 3.50 to a stone near a persimmon; thence N. 27° W. 4.55 to a stone in gulch; thence N. 11 E. 1.60 to a stone in gulch; thence N. 3 E. 32.15 to a stone on branch; thence N. 83 W. with tract of land conveyed to me by H. T. Austin on April 27th 1918, deed recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County S. C. Vol. 35 page 312.
