at and before the sealing of these presents by C. C. Hobbs(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. C. Hobbs

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Ward 10 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known as lots "A" and "B" according to a plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 410, and bearing the following Metes and bounds. Beginning at an iron post on the North side of East North Street, corner of lot "C" running thence N 13 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 200 feet to an iron pin, thence S 76 $\frac{3}{4}$  W 108 feet to an iron pin corner of H. P. McFee's lot, thence with McFee's line S 13 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 200 feet to an iron pin on North Street thence with North Street N 76 $\frac{3}{4}$  E 108 feet to beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Mette & James Co. by deed dated June 27<sup>th</sup> 1917 recorded in office R.
