All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning Line (aue) with Hill Street and running thence S. 2 1/4 W. 205 feet to iron spike on West side of Queen St. thence N. 88 W. 103 feet with right of way of Southern Railway Company to iron Spike, thence N. 4 E. 254 feet to stake on Hill Street; thence S. 62 1/2 E. 103 feet to the beginning corner and containing 5300 of an acre, more or less being the same lot as is conveyed to S.
