

DEED TO R. L. Dill

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Mrs. Nova L. Reid and Wm. Reid

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Sixty three and 8/100 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by R. L. Dill

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said R. L. Dill

Two-thirds interest in all that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on waters of Beaver Dam Creek, and being a part of the same land conveyed to J. S. Reid, deceased by Alexander P. Barker by deed bearing date of September 8th. 1870, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 17 at page 302, and more fully described as follows: Beginning at a stone on the South East side of the old State Road (formerly a persimmon) and thence S. 72 1/4 W. 17.00 chs. to a stone on R. L. Dill's line; thence N. 59 E. 7.20 chs. to an iron pin on East bank of a branch, thence down the said branch N. 48 E. 3.62 chs. to an iron pin in center of said branch; thence continuing down the said branch as the line in a north easterly course 6.75 chs. to a stake across Beaver Dam Creek, opposite the mouth of the aforementioned branch, on Mrs Jim Langley's line; thence with the said line S. 51 3/4 E. 4.70 chs. to a N. O. (gone) in the fill of the new State Road, thence S. 11 1/4 W. 3.20 chs. to the beginning corner, containing 2 1/2 and one seventh (6 1/7) acres more or less.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said R. L. Dill and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves and our

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said R. L. Dill and his

heirs and assigns, against us and our

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
