(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release  
unto the said, a forward, W. S. Ward, Hattie Hudson

+ Sarah Vaughan, their heirs and assigns,  
all my interest and estate and claim  
of dower in and to all that certain tract of  
land situate, lying and being in the County  
and State aforesaid, Beginning at a Hickory  
34, thence n. 65 E. 15.50 to a stone 34; thence n. 10  
E. 8.50 to a stone 34; thence n. 45 3/4 W. 9.50 to a  
stone 34; thence S. 37 W. 14.60 to a stone 34; thence  
S. 2 1/4 E. 4.54 to the beginning corner, and contain-  
ing twenty + one - half (20 1/2) acres, more or  
less, and being the same tract of land  
described in deed of S. J. Southit to Jas. B. Ward,  
dated November 1878, and recorded in R. M. B.  
Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book,  
Volume "99" Page 613, and being a part of a  
tract of one hundred sixty-four (164) acres  
conveyed by P. D. Silbreath, Sheriff of Greenville  
County, to S. J. Southit on June 1878, the deed  
to which is recorded in R. M. B. Office for  
Greenville County, in Deed Book, Volume  
"33", Page 701. This tract of 164 acres was sold  
by the Sheriff of Greenville County as the  
property of my husband, W. A. Hudson,  
deceased, and it does not appear from the  
records that I have ever renounced dower  
in and to the twenty + one - half (20 1/2) acre  
tract, and this deed of conveyance is made  
for the purpose of releasing and forever  
relinquishing all my right and claim  
of dower in and to said tract of land.
