of *Greenville*,in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Five Dollars and other valuable Considerations DOLLARS,
to *J. F. Meritt* in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. F. Meritt*(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said *J. F. Meritt*,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the State and County
aforesaid, in the Fifth Ward of the City of Greenville
known and designated as lot No. 6 of a plat made
by F. H. Rodger dated Feb. 12th 1912, and recorded
in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in
Plat Book "A" at page 547, and having according
to said plat the following metes and bounds,
to wit: Beginning at a stake on the Northeast
side of Beech Street, two hundred Sixty (260) feet
from Party's corner, and running thence along
said Street, S. 59-30 E. fifty-two (52) feet to a
stake on corner of lot No. 7; thence along line
of said lot N. 30-30 E. one hundred twenty-eight
(128) feet to a stake forty feet from the center
of the Railway track; thence along line of a
15-foot alley N. 39 1/2 W. fifty-five (55) feet to a
stake on corner of lot No. 5; thence S. 30-30 W.
one hundred forty-seven (147) feet along line
of lot No. 5 to the beginning corner, and being
the same tract of land conveyed to me by
Hoover L. Smith by his Deed dated March
23rd 1912, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Vol. 19 at page 55.
