KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. P. Poole, of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations \$5.00 &c.
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. B. Marshall

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. B. Marshall, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land,

situate, lying and being on Buncombe Road, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, about four miles from the court-house, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Buncombe Road, corner of Taylor Land, and running thence with said road S. 17 W. 414 feet and 3 inches to an iron pin, corner of Hughes Land; thence with Hughes line N. 84-3/4 W. 641-1/2 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with Hughes line N. 74-1/2 W. 2297 feet to stake on G. & K. R.R.; thence N. 41 E. 595 feet to stake; thence N. 61-3/4 E. 135 feet to stake; thence N. 56-1/2 E. 327 feet to a stake on branch, corner of Taylor Land; thence with the Taylor Line S. 65-1/4 E. 2406 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 45-1/2 acres, more or less, and being a part of the tract of land conveyed to me by my wife, Helena C. Poole by deed dated December 22nd, 1906 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in deed book Volume "TTM", page 302. See also deed of E. Irman, Master to J.P.
